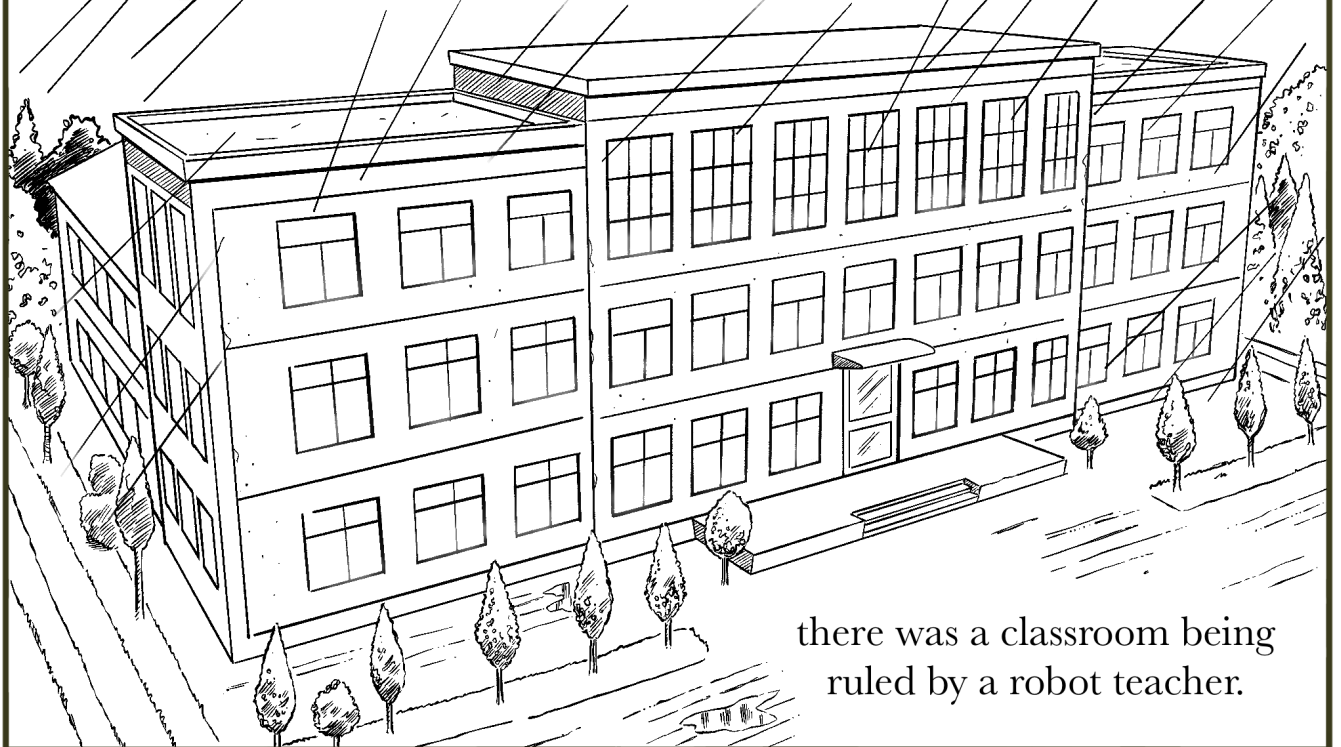

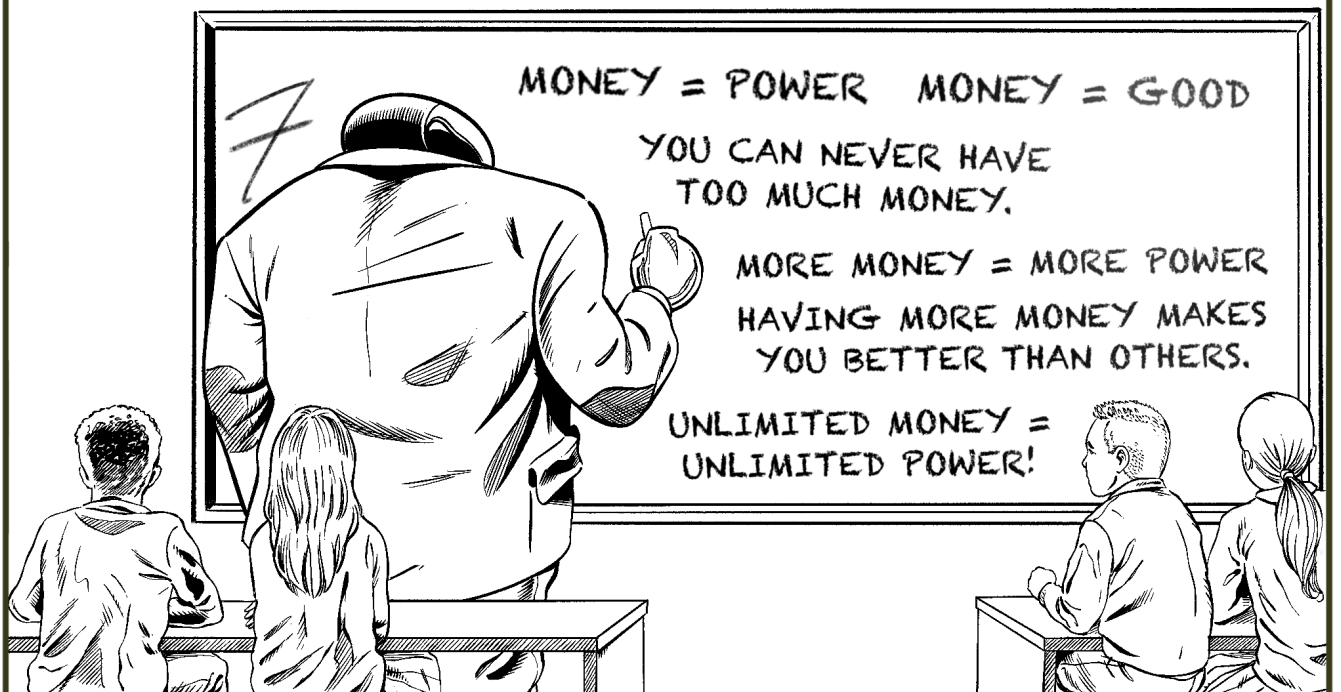


Once upon a time, in a rather ordinary school,



there was a classroom being ruled by a robot teacher.

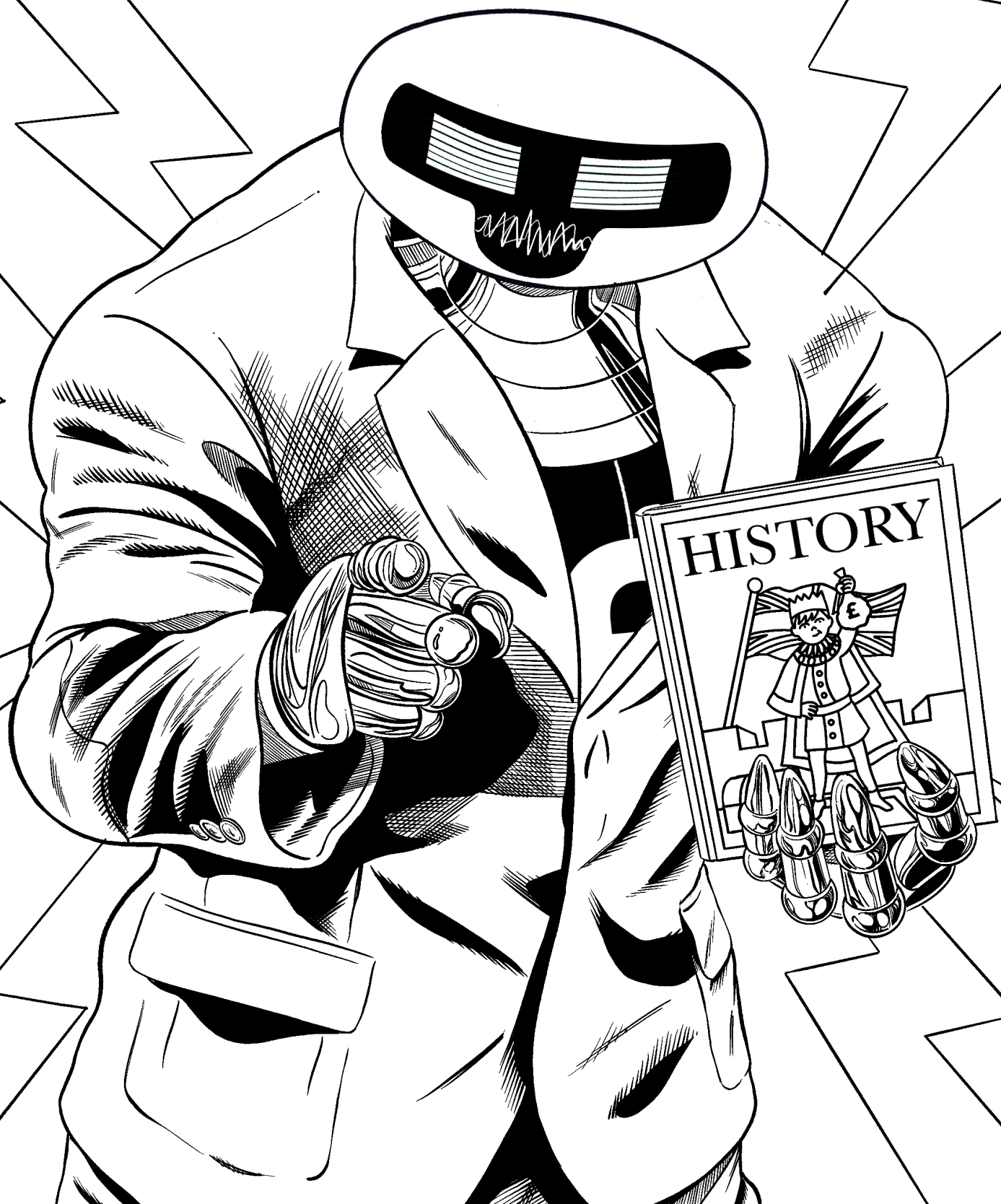
The robot was telling the children about money, saying,

Ever the curious child, Lisa raised her hand and politely asked, "But why must we learn only about money? Aren't there more important things in life?"

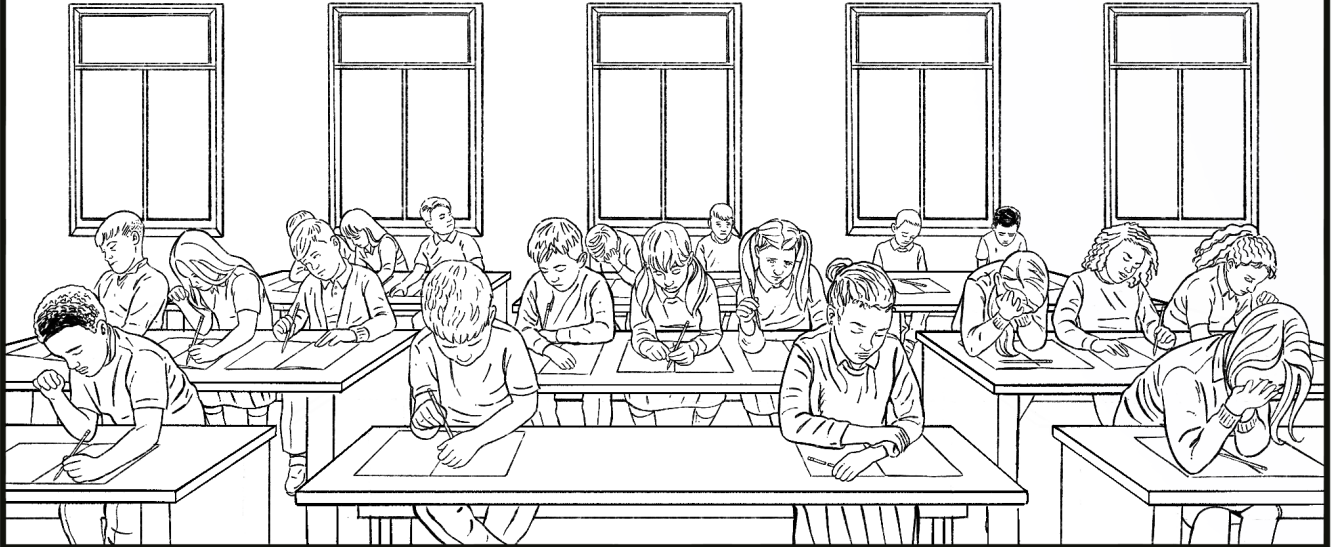


The robot teacher's voice crackled and then boomed, "No questions are allowed. You are here to learn only what we tell you to learn."

"leave the classroom as punishment for your questioning."



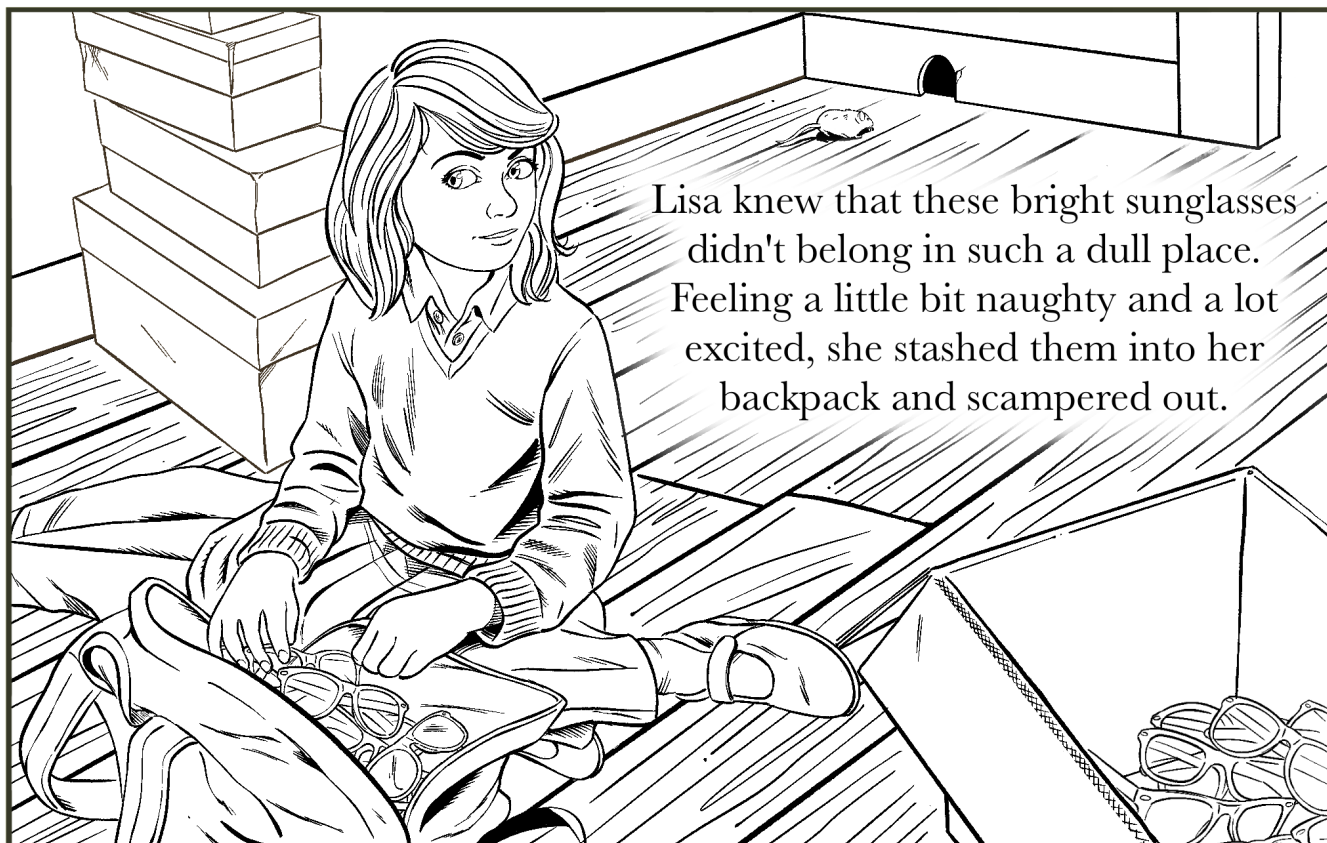


Outside the classroom in a musty corridor, Lisa approached a door that always remained locked. But today, inexplicably and quite invitingly, it was left ajar.

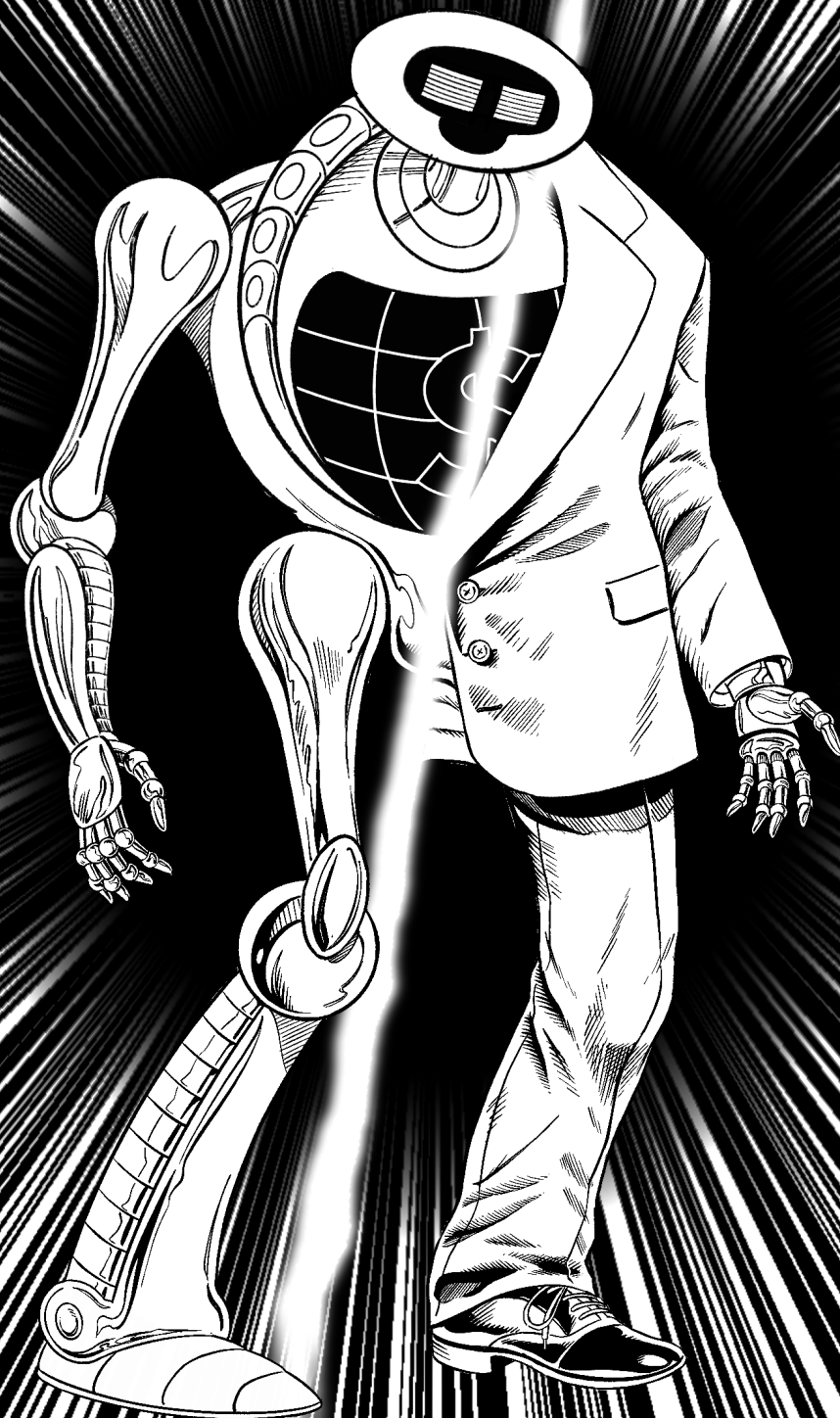




Lisa shared this secret with other children, and together they tried on the magical sunglasses.



To the children's surprise, with the magical sunglasses, they could see the robots for what they truly are. The robots' eyes glowed red, and a money sign was visible on their chests.

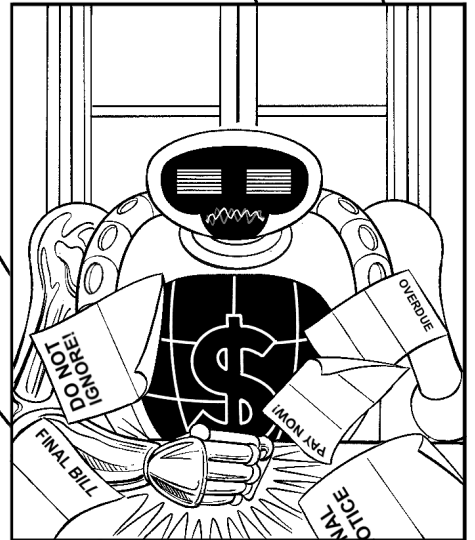
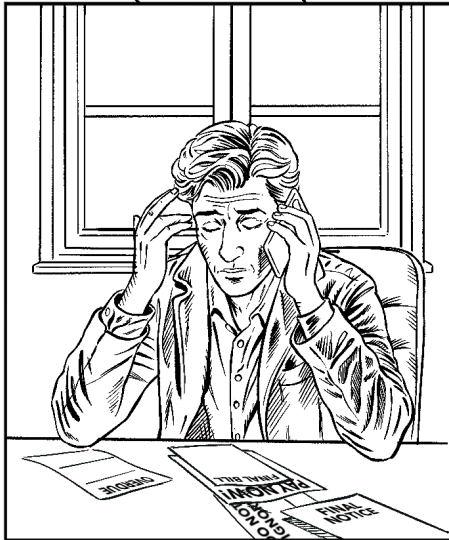
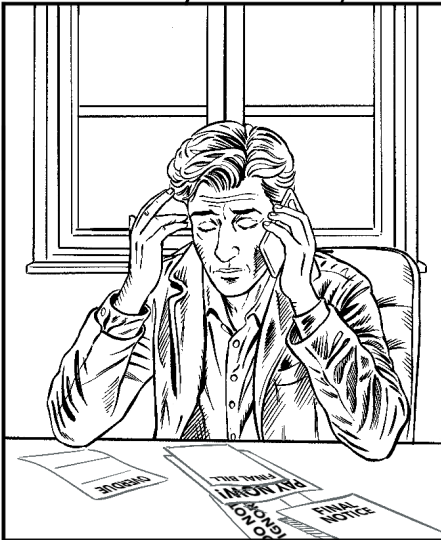
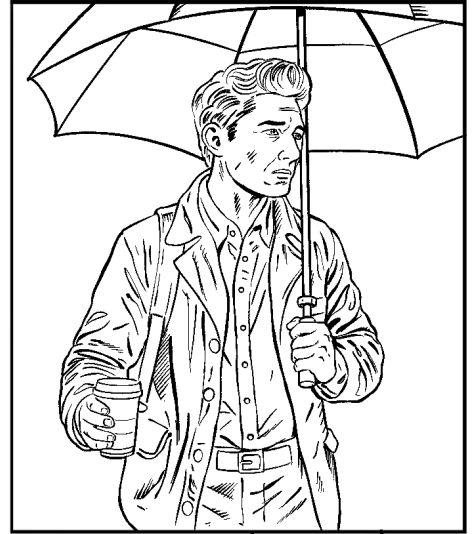
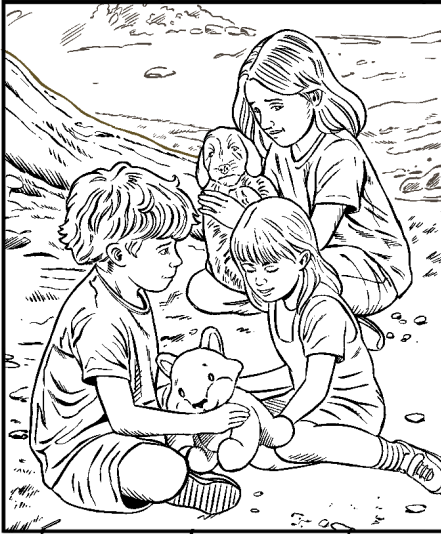




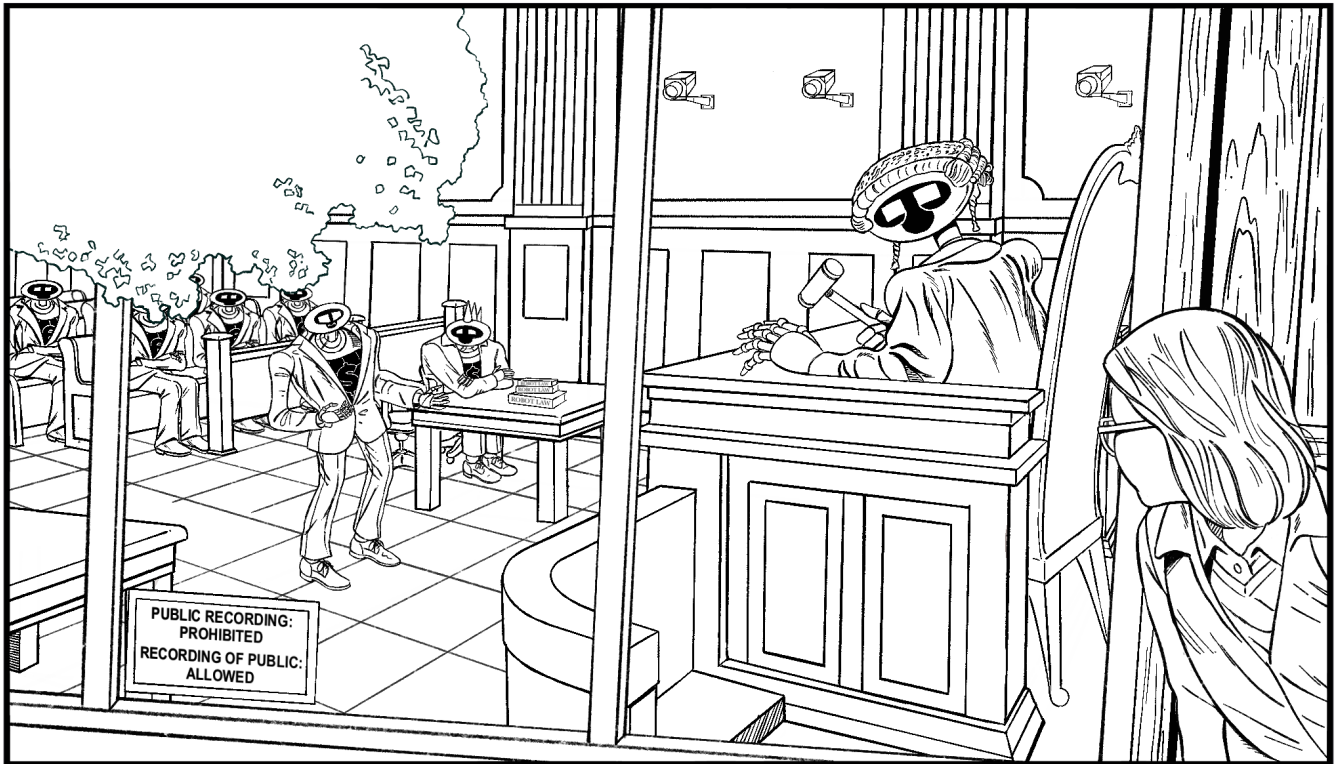
To their astonishment, the sunglasses also revealed

a forbidden forest.



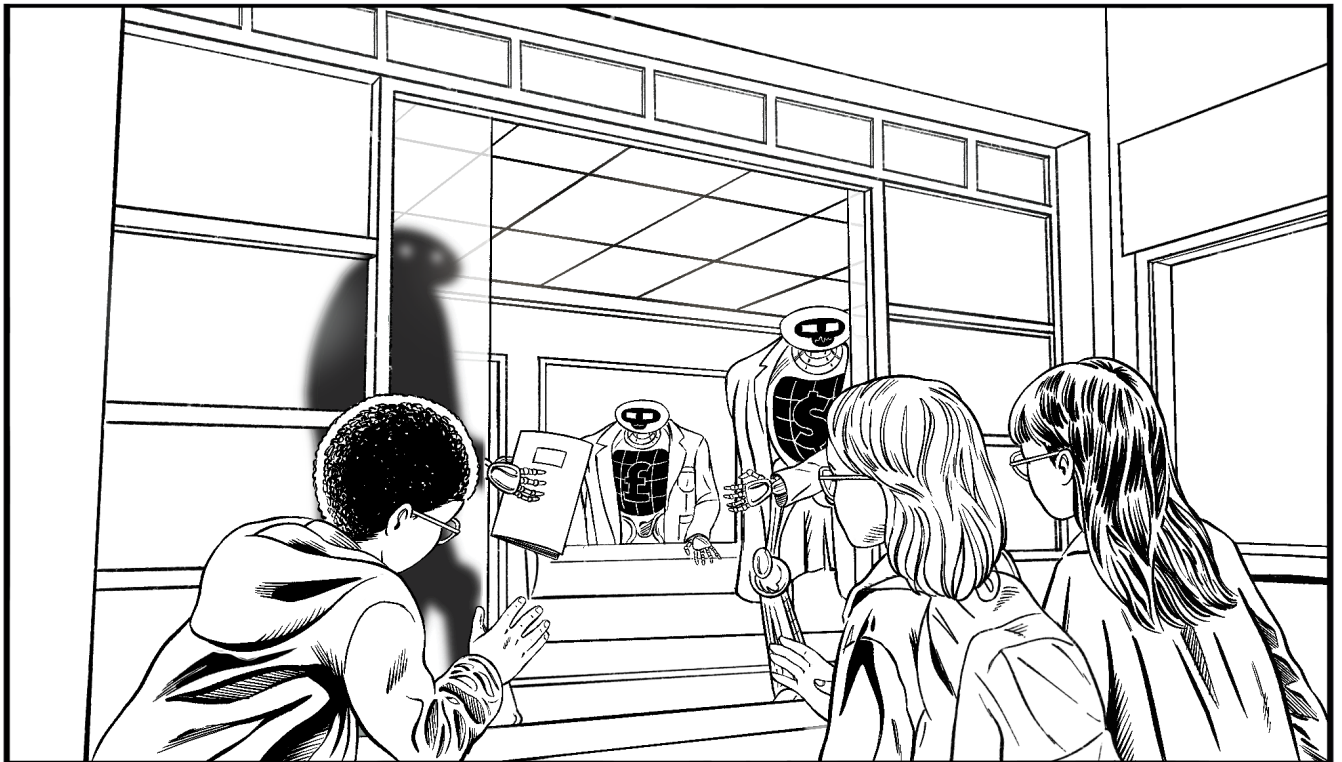

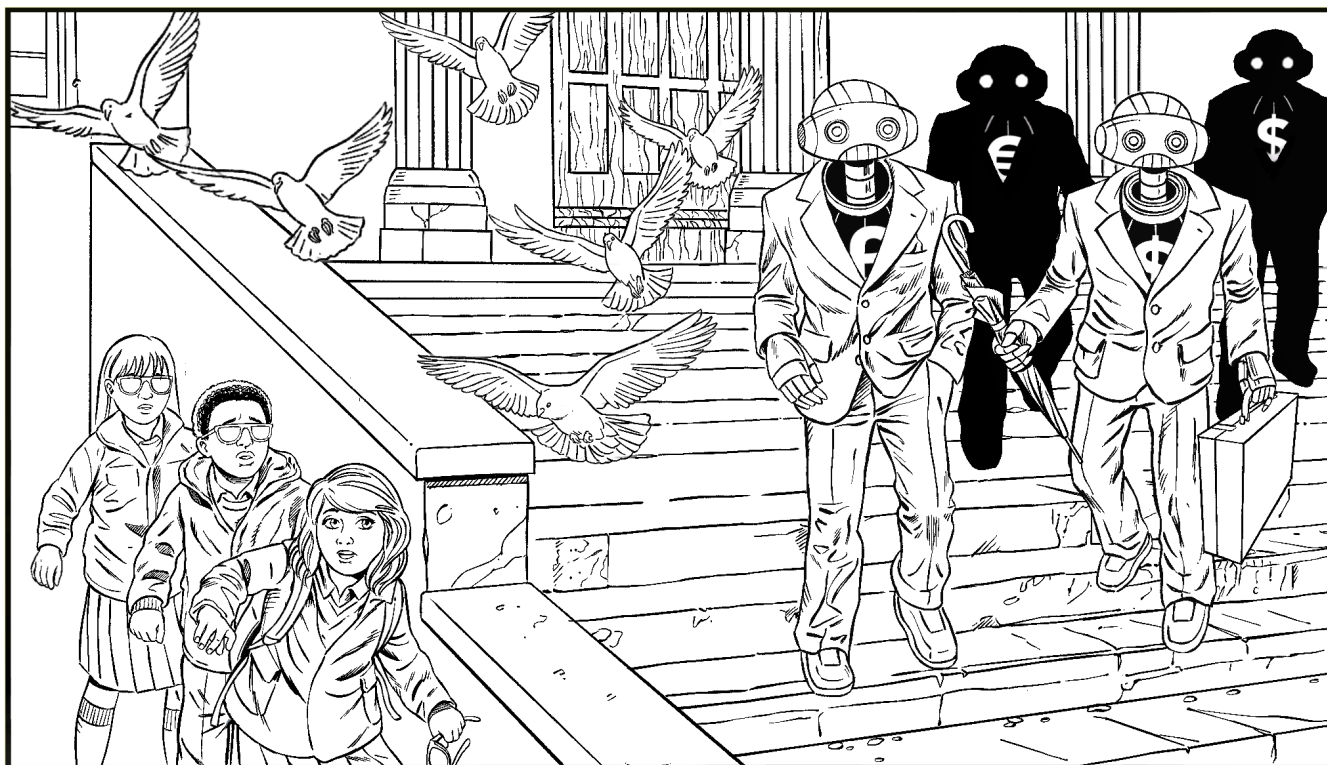
They even created a restriction zone in the forbidden forest to keep the children from discovering the secrets hidden there.



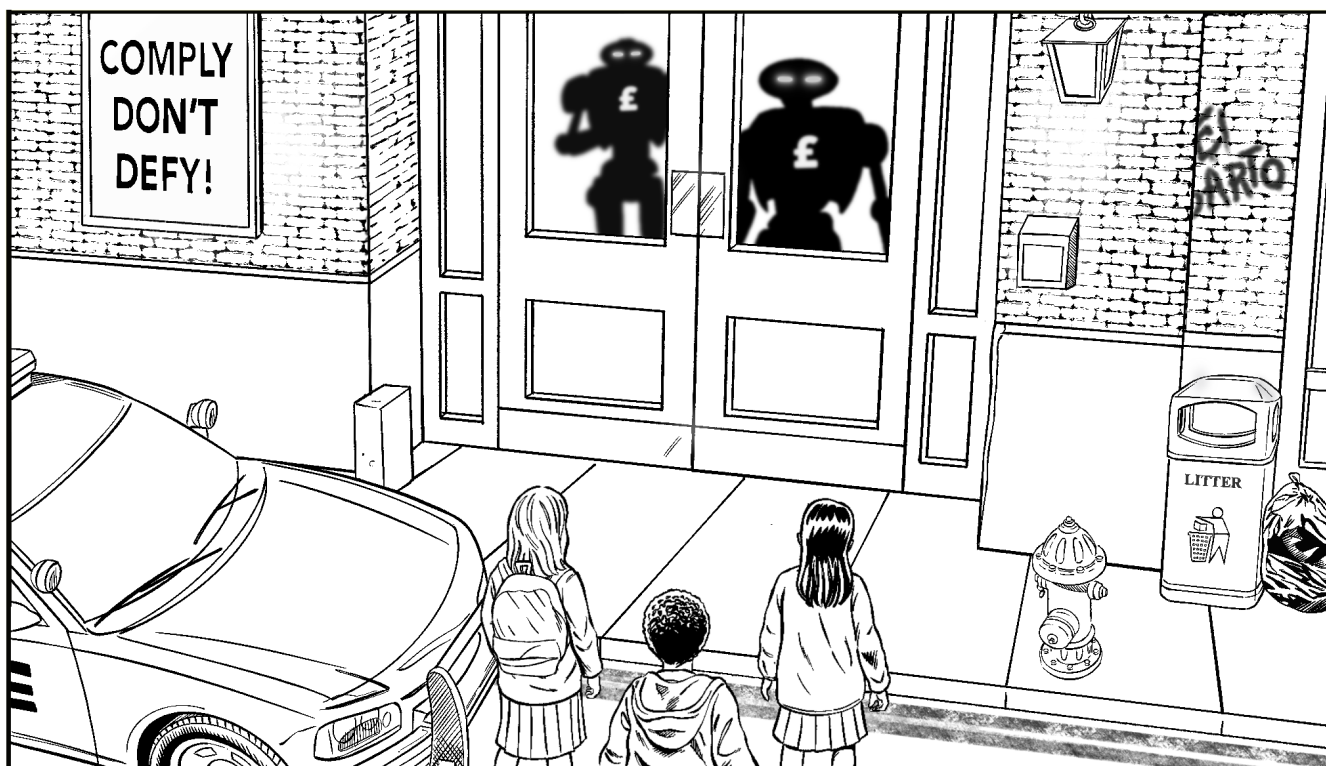
As Lisa and her friends walked through the town,

...the town hall, and the police station, all filled with red-eyed robots, their chests emblazoned with glowing money symbols.



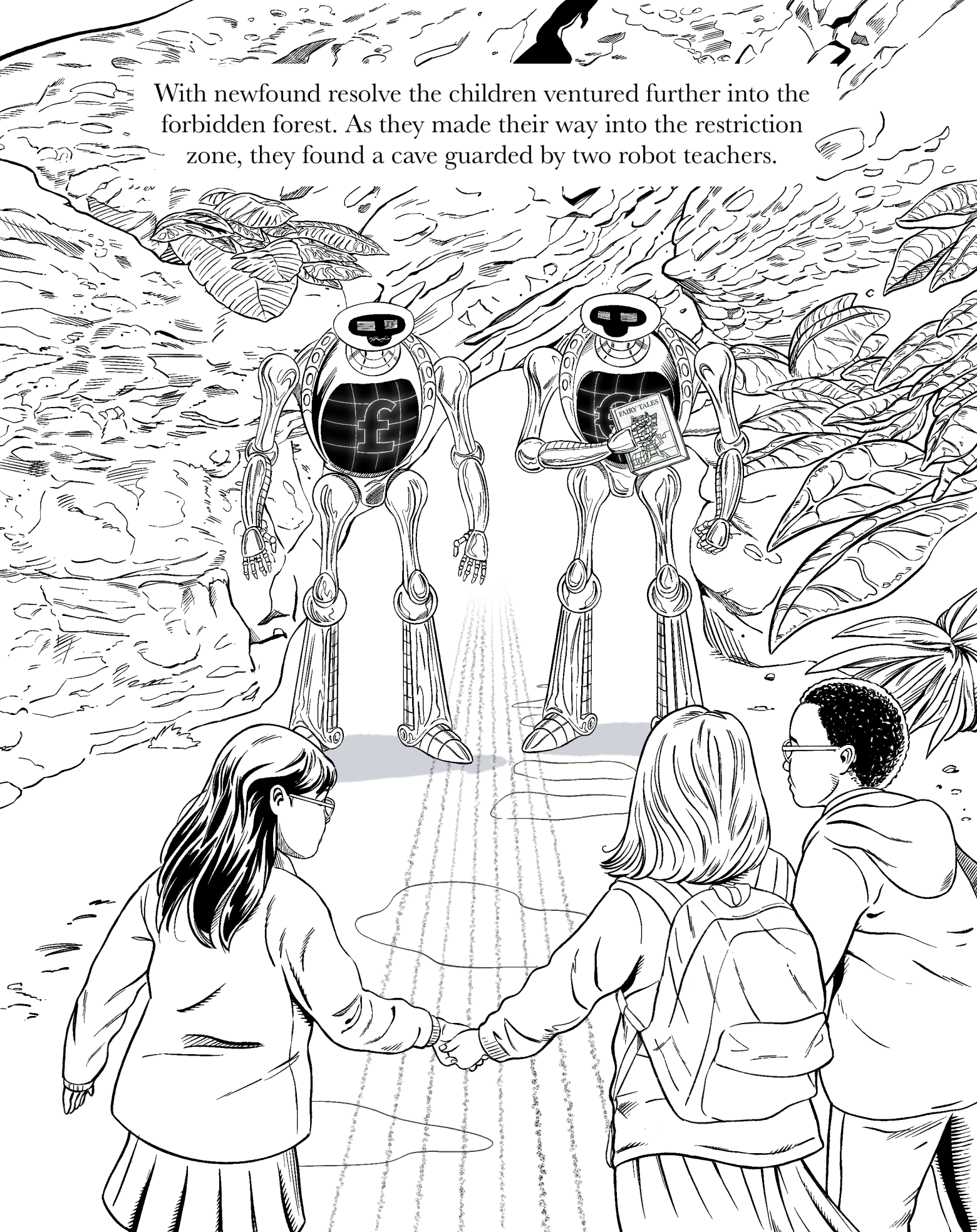

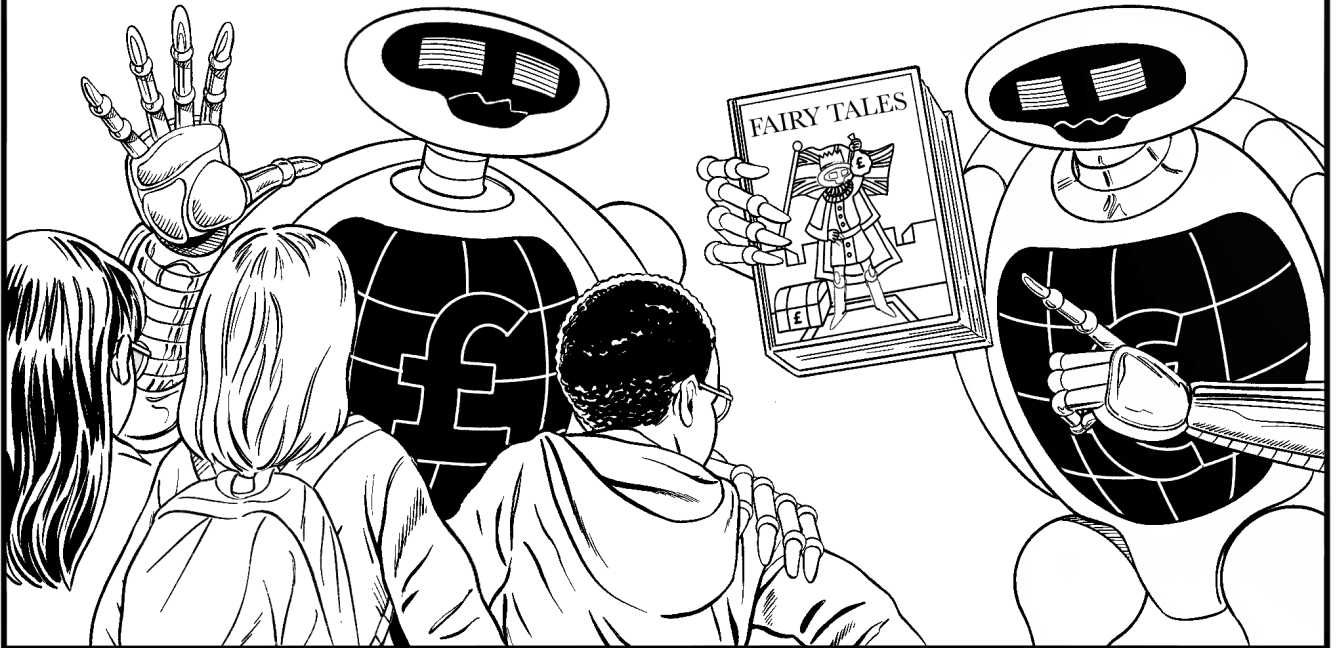

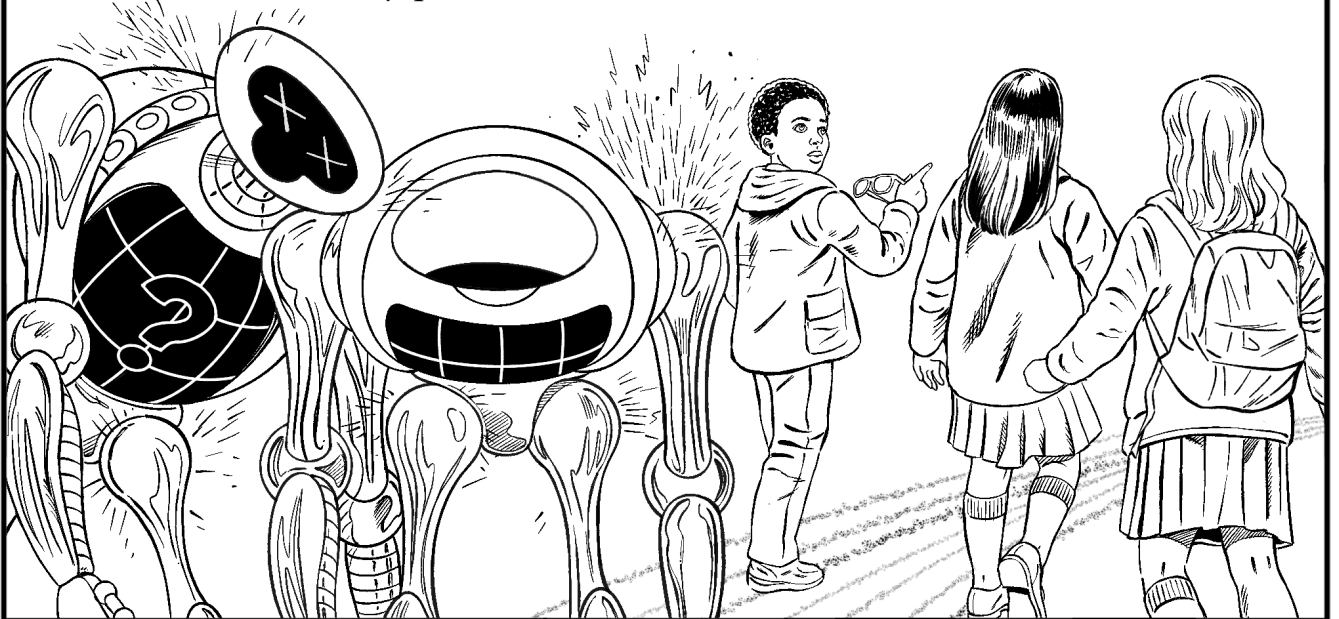
With newfound resolve the children ventured further into the forbidden forest. As they made their way into the restriction zone, they found a cave guarded by two robot teachers.

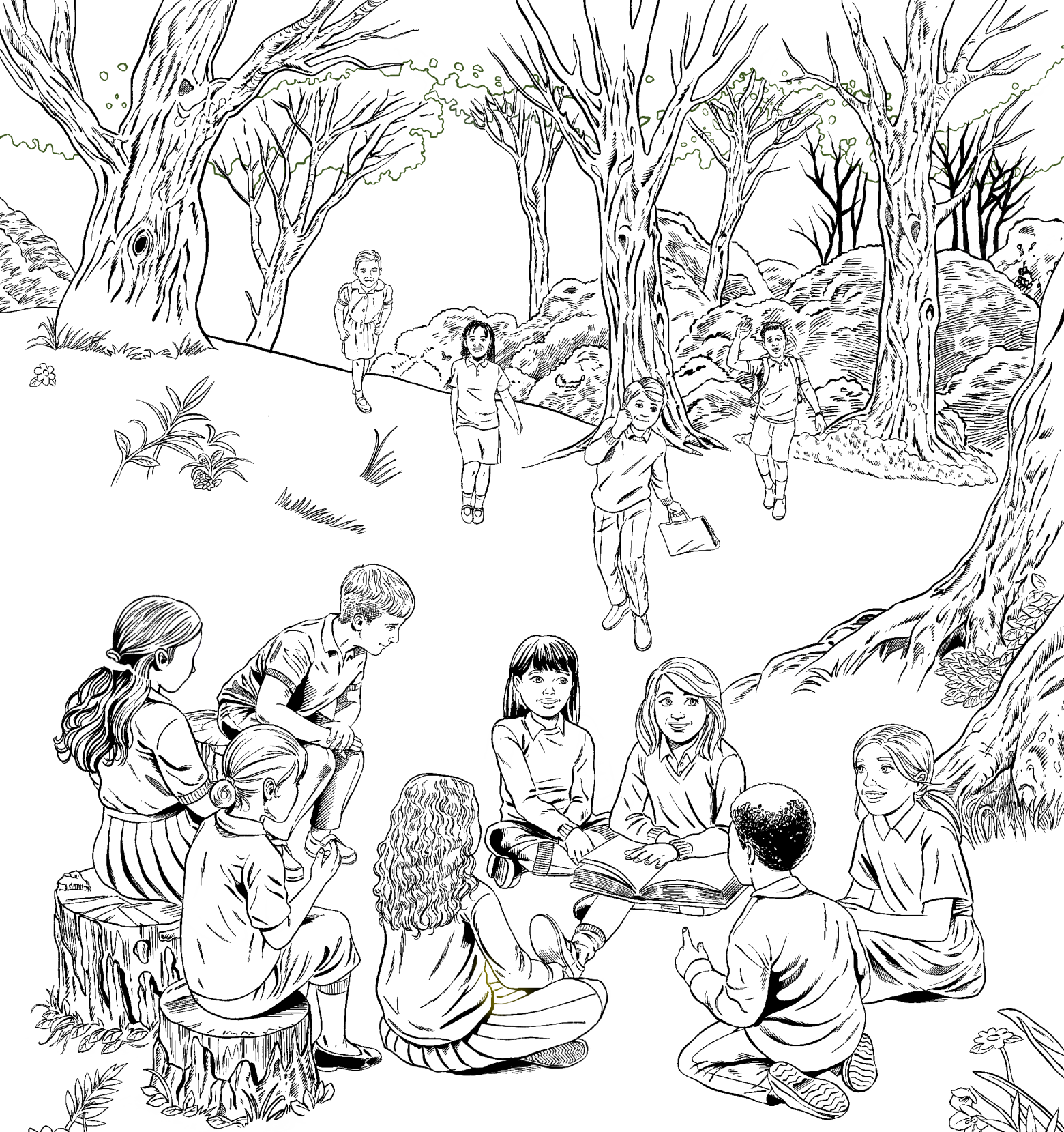




Emboldened, the children ventured deeper into the cave. In a shimmering blue chamber, they found the magical book of truth.





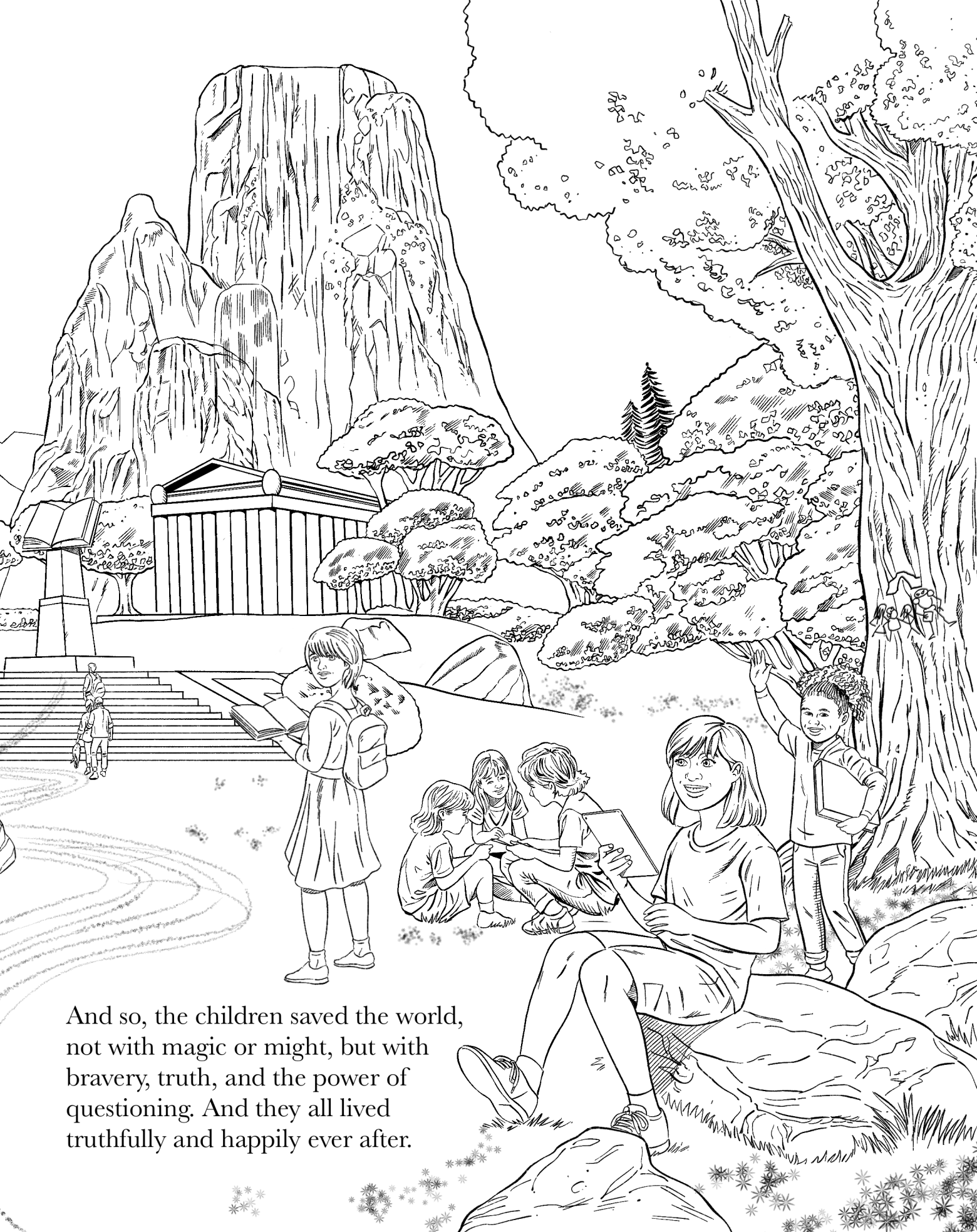


Using the book, they revealed the robots' secrets, and by sharing the information with other children, they began to shape the world for the better.



And filled the earth with hope instead.*

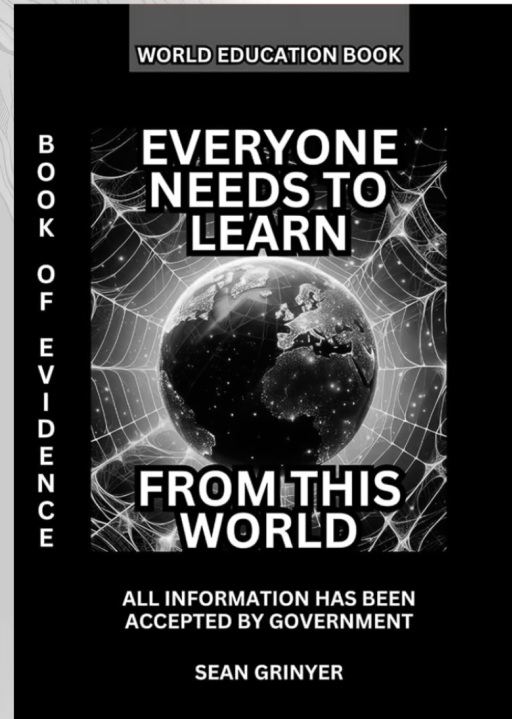
*Their tale lives on, through ages told,
